

## 68<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session Talking Points

- Montana voters sent a Republican supermajority to Helena with a conservative mandate and this session was one for the record books.
- The Legislature considered the most bills of any Legislature in **50 years**.
- Our Republican leaders worked early on in the session to return overpaid tax dollars to Montanans and provide the largest tax cut in Montana state history.
- Montanans will be receiving thousands of dollars apiece in tax rebates and paying lower taxes going forward into the future, with \$1 billion in total tax relief on its way to the citizens and businesses of our state.
- Governor Gianforte and Republican legislators also enacted bills that:
  - **Removed government regulations to assist with housing affordability for Montanans**  
*(84 legislators carried over 180 red tape relief bills)*
  - **Held our government accountable at all levels**
  - **Expanded educational opportunities for our youth**
  - **Defended our individual freedoms**
  - **Protected the Montana way of life**
- Republican lawmakers were good stewards of our taxpayer dollars and passed a balanced budget that holds the line on Government spending and record-high inflation.
- While the legislative session may be over, there is still more work to be done!
- As Republicans, we need to build off the successes of the 68<sup>th</sup> legislative session and work together to Keep Montana, Montana in 2024.
